Medical Laboratory Assistant – Laboratory – Temporary Part-Time

The Medical Laboratory Assistant (MLA) plays a vital role in supporting laboratory operations and ensuring accurate and timely diagnostic testing. This position is responsible for specimen collection, preparation, and processing in accordance with hospital policies, procedures, and the Standards of Practice for MLA/T as outlined by the Medical Laboratory Professionals in Ontario (MLPAO). The MLA works collaboratively with healthcare professionals to prioritize patient testing and maintain high standards of quality and safety.

Primary Duties

- Follow Standards of Practice for MLA/T (Medical Laboratory Assistant/Technician) per Medical Laboratory Professionals in Ontario (MLPAO)
- Follows hospital policies and procedures
- Follows written procedures in collection and receiving of specimens, including specimen rejection and relative documentation
- Inform clients of test preparation for specimen collection, ECG, and Holter monitor testing
- Communicate effectively with healthcare professionals regarding prioritization of specimen collection and patient testing
- Completes ECG (Electrocardiogram) and Holter monitor testing including documentation
- Collect, label and prepare patient samples (blood, urine, body fluids) for testing
- Operate and maintain laboratory equipment, ensuring proper functionality
- Perform routine laboratory tests and assist in more complex procedures
- Prepare specimens for referral to reference laboratories
- Maintain accurate patient records and ensure proper documentation
- Follow safety protocols and handle hazardous materials responsibly
- Assists with student training
- Assists with inventory management by requesting supplies as needed
- Maintains confidentiality of records and information
- Is knowledgeable of the quality management system
