The Physiotherapist is an important part of the interdisciplinary team, working on our in-patient Medical/surgical unit. The Physiotherapist provides consultation, assessment, intervention, and education in order to help our patients reach their rehabilitation goals.

Primary Duties

- Conduct comprehensive assessments of patients, including reviewing test results, gathering medical history, and understanding rehabilitation goals.
- Develops and implements individualized treatment plans to address physical impairments and enhance mobility, strength and overall function.
- Determines treatment techniques and application of assistive devices in consultation with other health care professionals, reassesses performance and modifies the treatment appropriately
- Educates patients, caregivers and family members regarding therapeutic exercises, injury prevention and lifestyle modifications.
- Coordinates with the interdisciplinary team and other community resources, including family members, to
 facilitate appropriate physiotherapy follow-up, acquisition of required equipment, and provision of a home
 exercise program
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date patient records, documenting progress and outcomes
- Participate in hospital-wide initiatives to promote wellness and rehabilitation services.

Education Requirements:

- Completion of a Master's Degree in Physiotherapy from an accredited institution
- Current registration with the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario
- Member of CPA Professional Association preferred
- Continuing education or certifications in specialized areas of physiotherapy is an asset
- Post-graduate manual therapy and Neurodevelopmental (NDT) programs are an asset

Required Qualifications:

- Ability to work accurately and efficiently in a fast-paced environment using excellent organizational and time management skills to prioritize duties.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work effectively with patients, families, other professionals and interdisciplinary team members as well as the ability to work independently.
- Ability to represent the Hospital with professionalism and compassion for patients and families.
- Ability to assess, evaluate and communicate appropriate Physiotherapy treatment plans.
- Demonstrated knowledge of technical and mechanical skills for operation of modalities and gym equipment
- Computer skills, knowledge of Microsoft Office and ability to learn how to use an electronic charting system.
