Position summary: Campbellford Memorial Hospital is seeking a dedicated and reliable Temporary Full-Time PSW to support the Inpatient Unit. The Personal Support Worker is accountable to the Inpatient Unit Manager and provides personal care and other routine activities of daily living for patients with predictable outcomes under the direction of an RN or RPN. They assume a participatory role on the interdisciplinary health care team as assigned by the RN and RPN and expand the team's ability to provide safe, patient-centered care while adhering to hospital policies and the CUPE collective agreement guidelines.

Duties: Assist patients with activities of daily living (ADLs), including bathing, dressing, grooming and toileting. Support mobility and transfers, including lifting and repositioning patients safely. Provide feeding assistance and monitor nutritional intake. Observe, document and report changes in patient condition to nursing staff. Maintain a clean and safe environment, ensuring infection control protocols are followed. Offer emotional support and companionship to patients. Assist with transporting patients within the hospital for tests or procedures, support rehabilitation activities as directed by a health professional. Collaborate with nurses and other healthcare team members to ensure holistic patient care.

Qualifications:

- Personal Support Worker (PSW) Certificate or Diploma form a recognized educational institution
- Certificate in Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)
- · Current CPR and First Aid certification
- Knowledge of infection control practices and patient safety protocols



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Required Skills:

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills to interact effectively with patients and families and healthcare teams
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Compassionate and patient-centered approach to care
- Ability to perform moderately heaving work, including lifting up to 40 lbs.
- Excellent organizational skills and time management skills
- Ability to adapt to changing patient needs and hospital environment
- Strong communication skills
- Familiarity with common health conditions, mobility equipment and safety procedures

Hours of Work: 12 hour shifts 7 days a week, days, nights, weekends and holidays
