



Physiotherapist – Permanent Full Time

The Physiotherapist is an important part of the interdisciplinary team, working on our in-patient Medical/surgical unit. The Physiotherapist provides consultation, assessment, intervention, and education in order to help our patients reach their rehabilitation goals.

Primary Duties

- Assesses patient, including review of test results, gathering patient history, current status and rehabilitation goals
- Determines current physical impairments and disabilities, communicates the results to the patient and documents accordingly
- Determines treatment techniques and application of assistive devices in consultation with other health care professionals, reassesses performance and modifies the treatment appropriately
- Educates caregivers and family members in activities that support the intervention plan
- Coordinates with the interdisciplinary team and other community resources, including family members, to facilitate appropriate physiotherapy follow-up, acquisition of required equipment, and provision of a home exercise program
- Use appropriate outcome measures to determine when the client has achieved goals or maximum benefit from PT services, or is no longer appropriate for PT intervention because of changes in health status

- Completion of a Master's Degree in Physiotherapy from a recognized University
- Licensed to practice with the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario
- Member of CPA Professional Association preferred
- Post-graduate manual therapy and Neurodevelopmental (NDT) programs are an asset
